Depicting a lushly hued hybridized creature about to reach out its chicken-leg arm to grab the emoji-like, pristinely impenetrable "cupcake" constructed of tofu cubes and an asparagus "candle", 2019's Vegan perfectly exemplifies Epp's adroitly penetrating circulation of the avatars of daily late capitalist practices. As in the rest of the artist's work, the portrayed idealism of - in this case - a vegan's self-righteous asceticism is contrasted with the creature's mouth full of a carnivore's vampiric teeth and a setting reminiscent of a theatrical stage, alluding, as in the rest of the series, to the performative nature of public virtue.
